

He grew up on the family's dairy, Hendel Farms, and was a true farm kid who loved all things farming, along with dirt bikes, snowmobiles, and cars as he grew older.

Karl graduated from Caledonia High School and went on to receive a degree in Dairy Science from the University of Minnesota – Waseca. He then attended the University of Minnesota – St. Paul.

In 1990, Karl and brother, Matt, began their partnership at Hendel Farms. Karl was proud to continue the legacy of their 4th generation family farm which began in 1869. As both brothers and working partners, Karl and Matt shared both mutual respect and admiration for each other. Together, they made progressive changes to the farm and focused on their dairy herd. They received numerous awards and recognition for their farm management practices, outstanding milk quality, and elite registered Brown Swiss and Holstein herd. However, Karl was never one who liked to be the focus of attention. He remained quietly behind the scenes doing what he loved best, tending to the farm and cows.

Karl was a caring and loving brother, uncle, and friend. He was

especially proud of his nieces and nephews. As they were growing up, he was a playful uncle who loved to take them on tractor rides, four wheeling or hunting. He shared his love of the farm with them and spent many hours with them in the milking parlor. Karl was always present for their life events. He thoroughly enjoyed family gatherings and after his house was built, he was pleased to host some of the family holidays.

For more than twenty years, Karl hosted a Tuesday night gathering which he called the "Board Meeting" in the farm's upstairs breakroom. It was a casual meeting of friends, co-workers, business partners or relatives, anyone was welcome to stop in. Karl enjoyed nature and the outdoors. His trips away from the farm were usually to go snowmobiling with friends. He especially liked sledding in the UP of Michigan. We will miss Karl's quick wit and sense of humor followed by his distinct chuckle.



Competitive Teams



Dairy Challenge

UW-Madison is committed to its students receiving a "Dairy Challenge" experience. In fact, within our curriculum we offer Nutrition Experience, Dairy Herd Management Practicum, and Dairy Challenge courses. Within this coursework, students are mentored on how to analyze a commercial dairy farm and provide management recommendations to the farm ownership, honing skills that translate directly to the Dairy Challenge contest and their future careers. Our students participate competitively at the Midwest and National North American Intercollegiate Dairy Challenge competitions.

At the 2024 National Contest in California, UW was one of the four teams awarded first place. We feel the ability of our students to excel in this competitive format speaks to the quality of their education. UW team members graduate with a sophisticated knowledge of the science of dairying and the ability to effectively communicate that knowledge.

Dairy Judging

UW-Madison's dairy judging program has a long-standing tradition of success that continues today. At the National Intercollegiate Dairy Cattle Judging Contest, UW has earned 9 first place finishes. Our coaches are highly regarded for their "cow ability" and talent to teach students about functional type and presenting winning oral reasons.

The judging team is typically comprised of around 15 students, each of whom are guaranteed to compete in a contest. In fact, a majority of team members will participate in three or four contests over their collegiate judging career. The dairy judging team competes in the fall and we send teams to the Viroqua Intercollegiate Contest (WI), Pennsylvania All-American (PA), North American (KY), Fort Worth Stock Show (TX) and World Dairy Expo (WI) contests.





GOLDEN GOPHER FUTURITY L

- TWO-YEAR OLD FUTURITY -

This will be a continuing program competition the 2024 designated as Futurity No. L. One nomination is required for each animal that competes. New this year competition will be in one category - type only. As a reminder, the Production Futurity will no longer be continued. Last applicants will be awarded in 2025. All nominations are the responsibility of the owner and must be made on regulation entry blanks, along with specified fees, postmarked by the nomination date and other rules. All money received from the nominations in the Futurity class shall make up the purse entered on the basis of their placings.

Any registered Holstein female, owned by a Minnesota Holstein Association member, and born from 9/01/23 through 8/31/24 is eligible for Golden Gopher Futurity L. One payment of \$25 shall be paid by 12/1/24.

A breeder may nominate any number of females in the type futurity. Nominations must be postmarked no later than the due date.

TYPE FUTURITY

Animals nominated will be shown in a special two-year old futurity class at the Minnesota State Show, in 2026, winners and awards to be based on the placing at that show. Showing in this class does not eliminate her from showing in the All-Minnesota two-year old classes. All rules and regulations of the show are to be adhered to. Placings will be made by an official show judge. The purse shall consist of all money received by nomination fees, less the expenses for its promotion and management. All money will be kept in a special fund and used only for futurity purposes. Money received for L nominations will only be used for animals entered in that class. The money in this class will be divided among placings as follow:

First Place - 15%; 2nd Place - 10%; 3rd Place - 8%; 4th Place - 6%; 5th Place 5%; 6-10 Placings - 4%; 11-15 Placings - 3%; 16-25 Placings - 2%. Remaining 1% to be used for administration fees.

If fewer than 25 animals are competing, the remainder will be divided equally among the entries.

All nomination fees are committed to the purse. No refunds will be made whether an animal completes or eligibility is discontinued.

Any animal sold after being nominated will remain eligible if the new owner is a Minnesota Holstein member.

The Minnesota Holstein Association is sponsoring and governing the futurity and will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with the show.




