Virtual Contest Day Information

Photo Contest

Do you have a great photo from a junior event or one of you with your project animal? Attach them on your google form when you sign up for convention. The photos will be put into a google form to be voted on by other junior members. Submitted photos will also be considered for inclusion on Minnesota's Banner at the 2021 National Junior Convention.

Public Speaking Contest

The prepared public speaking contest is open to all juniors ages 9-21. Contestants can choose any subject pertaining to dairy cattle and the dairy industry.

Juniors - ages 9-13, 3-5 minute speech Intermediates - ages 14-17, 6-8 minute speech Seniors - ages 18-21, 6-8 minute speech

Speeches will be given on zoom; participants will give their speech to a judge with nobody else present. Each speech will be recorded on zoom to accommodate for any internet issues.

Dairy Bowl

Dairy Bowl is one of the big events MJHA members can compete in at convention. Juniors will have the opportunity to display their knowledge of the Holstein breed and the dairy industry. Dairy Bowl will be held via zoom, and participants will have the opportunity to form their own teams or be paired with other junior members upon request. All participants will gather in one large zoom room for rules. When your team is participating you will be put into a breakout room with the team you are against. The contest will be conducted as normal, with phase one consisting of 12 questions to be answered individually by one team at a time, and phase two consisting of 15 toss-up questions that members of either team can answer. We will be using a program called ccg.buzz to "buzz in." This program allows us to see which participant buzzes in first keeping the contest fun and fair.

Junior members who are not in the breakout room participating in the contest will stay in the large zoom room to chat with other junior members and games put together by board members.

Dairy Jeopardy

Dairy Jeopardy is a contest for individuals who are quick on the buzzer and want to test his or her dairy knowledge. The contest is open to all Minnesota Junior Holstein members ages 9-21. Dairy Jeopardy will be using the same platforms as Dairy Bowl. Participants will have the opportunity to buzz in to answer questions for their respective point values.

PBR & Long Range Production Awards

Long range production awards for 50,000 100,000 and 150,000 pounds of milk will be given out to juniors at the convention banquet. Long range production awards will be open to all breeds. High milk, high fat, and high protein awards are also given for the age divisions 2-year-olds, 3-year-olds, 4-year-olds, and 5-years over. The Minnesota Junior Progressive Breeders Registry award will also be presented at the banquet. The application for these awards need to be submitted to the MHA office by February 19, 2021. This is a great way for you to get the recognition that both you and your cow deserve. *Application available online*.
